With growing concerns over the novel coronavirus (COVID-19), I wanted to share the actions Habitat for Humanity Camrose is taking to ensure our retail location, build site and administrative office are clean and safe for you, our team members and the public we serve.

In response to the COVID-19 pandemic, following the lead of Canadian and local public health authorities, we have taken additional safety measures to ensure your safety as well as the safety of our teams:

- We have postponed all public events and volunteer activities through the end of March and will re-assess the situation for April
- We are monitoring updates from local health authorities daily and providing our team members with daily briefings
- We have enhanced cleaning protocols that includes all high-touch areas (door handles, public bathrooms) and have continued to use top-grade disinfectants
- We have increased the use of antibacterial hand sanitizers
- We have limited all non-essential travel and in-person meetings for our team members

We recognize that there is much uncertainty at this time as it is an ever-evolving situation. We will continue to be diligent in monitoring and following the Government of Alberta guidelines. If you have any questions or concerns, please contact me at the email provided below.
